

ABOUT NICOLÒ





Discipline: WorldSSP

At 3 years old he got the chance to try a go-kart for the first time and the next year he really found his passion after riding a minimoto. In 2007 Nicolò attended the Minimoto Italian Championship with Team Speedy Sport and in his second year he ended the Championship in 4th place with 2 podiums in the Junior A (2S) category. In 2010 Nicolò took on the MiniGP Italian Championship in Davide Capirossi's team. He finished the season in 4th place in the Italian Championship and 3rd in the European Championship taking part in a single race in Germany.

In 2011 Bulega moved to TEAM RMU and won the MiniGP 50 Italian Champsionship. He was also crowned European Champion in France. The results kept coming in 2013 when Bulega, with the family team JNB Sport Business, again on his debut, won the Championship in the 250 PreGP category finishing 1st in 6 of the 6 races.

Nicolò started his experience in the VR46 Riders Academy in 2014 and lined up at the start of the Spanish CEV with the Calvo team Moto3, finishing 6th. In 2015 Nicolò made his first appearance in the MotoGP Moto3 World Championship racing at the Valencia Grand Prix as a wild card on a KTM RC 250 GP for the SKY Racing Team VR46. Nicolò won the Moto3 Junior World Championship, affirming himself as the first ever Italian rider to win a Championship in one of the CEV categories

The year after, he officially participated in the Moto3 World Championship. At the Spanish Grand Prix, he got his first pole position and his first podium in the World Championship. 3rd place in Japan and Nicolò ended the season in 7th place with a score of 129 points. In the following 2 seasons, Bulega attended the Moto3 World Championship with the same team and bike.

2019 was the first year in the Moto2 World Championship with the Sky Racing Team while 2021 was his last, riding for Team Federal Oil Gresini, since in 2022 he made is debut in the Supersport World Championship with the Ducati Panigale V2 of Aruba.it Racing Ducati Team, finishing 4th. But it was in 2023 that with a fantastic season he was crowned world champion in the SSP category. On 5th September 2023 it was announced that Nicolò will race for the same team in 2024 but in SBK alongside Alvaro Bautista.
